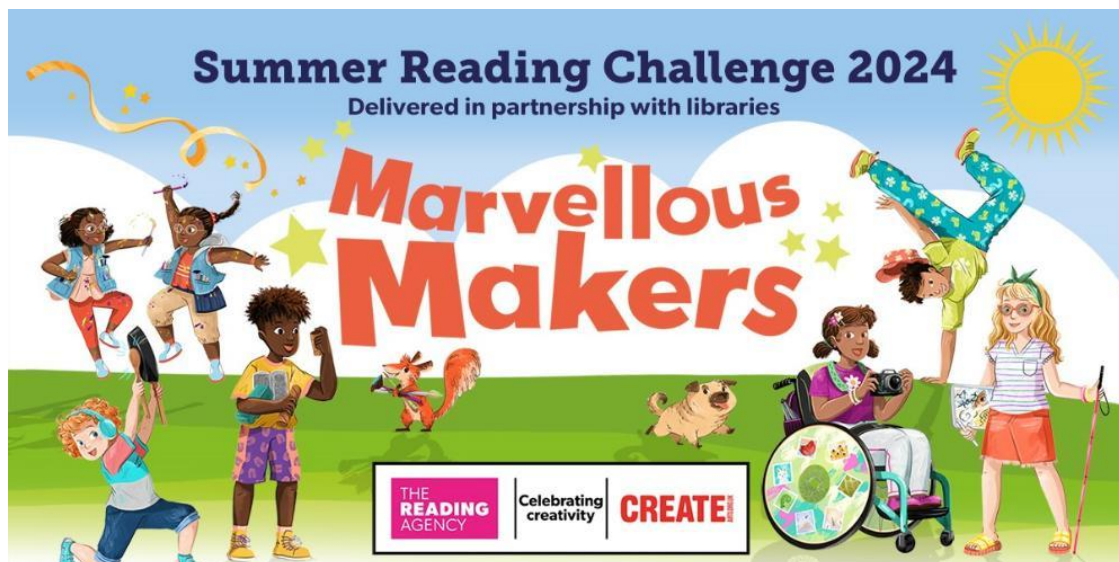
Sports Day

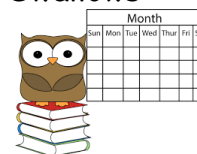
