Norfolk County Council Food Vouchers

We are please to say the NCC have extended the food voucher scheme until March 2025. If you are eligible for Free School Meals, you will automatically be send monthly vouchers to spend in your local supermarket. To check you eligibility for Free School Meals, please visit https://www.norfolk.gov.uk/38166

Please note that this is different to the Universal Free School meals that all children get until the end of year 2.

In addition to this, anyone who is experiencing hardship may be able tot receive support through the Norfolk Assistance Scheme (NAS), which may be able to provide financiel support, including essential household items.
