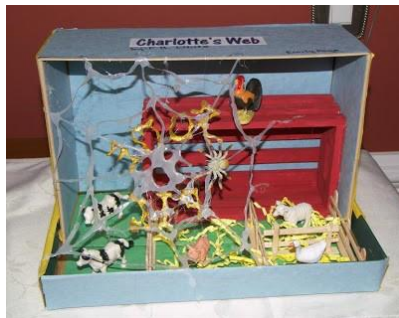

For making an amazing poster for the beach clean. He has now earned his Eco badge, well done!





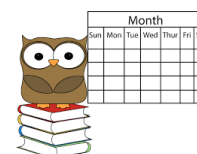
Year 5 Bikeability
