Fruit Kebab Friday

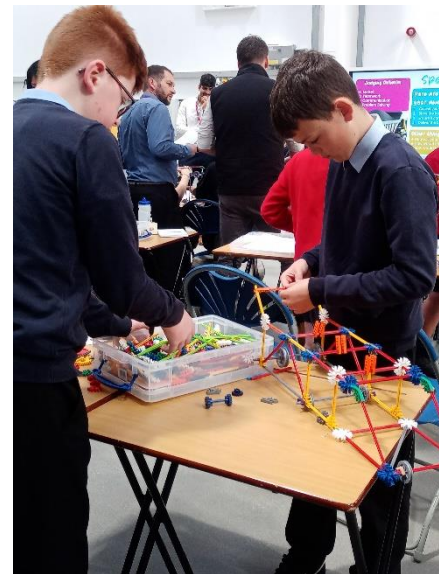
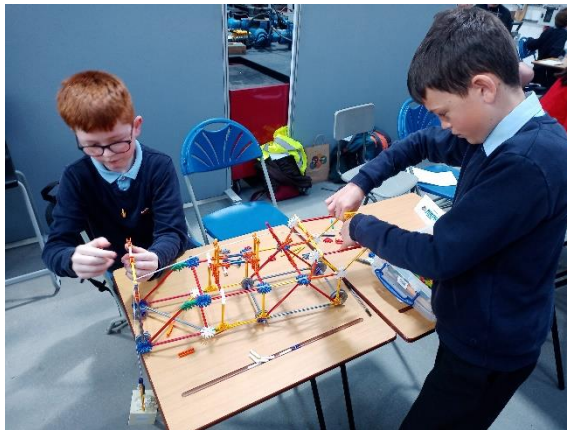

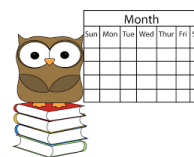
